



## New Rental Rates for 2007

Camp Paddy Run is managed on a volunteer basis and relies heavily on the groups and individuals that use the property to help support the camp. Therefore, the Paddy Run Outdoor Ministry Committee has approved a new rental fee structure that reflects current market rates that are similar, or still less, than fees at area campgrounds, picnic shelters or national parks. Because we are owned and supported by the Presbytery Shenandoah, fees for member churches offer a cost savings.

We welcome your feedback regarding this new rate structure. New rates will go into effect April 2007.

### Shenandoah Presbytery Groups :

#### ◆ Unlimited, exclusive overnight use of the all facilities on the property- pool, lodge, etc:

Weekend rates\* Fri-Sun: \$50 minimum for up to 10 people;  
\$5 for each additional person up to \$150 maximum fee per day.

Weekday rates\* Mon-Thurs: \$30 minimum for up to 10 people,  
\$3 for each additional person up to \$75 day maximum fee per day.

#### ◆ Non-exclusive rentals: property may be shared with multiple groups at one time:

Tenting or Use of Cabins Only: \$30 weekend/ \$20 weekday for up to 10 people;  
( no lodge use ) \$2 per additional person

Use of Picnic Shelter/ Day Use only: \$50 minimum for up to 25 people;  
( use of lodge kitchen & bathrooms) \$2 for each additional person up to \$75 maximum fee per day.

Use of Pool: Add \$25 to rental fee per day

Meetings ( up to 3 hours ): donation appreciated

#### Notes:

\*Children under 6 are free.

Parties of less than 10 people will still be charged the minimum amount of \$30 - \$50.

Reservations are honored on a first come, first serve basis with signed rental agreement and deposit. Deposit is equal to the minimum rate ( \$30 - \$50 ) or 20% of the total reservation fee, whichever is greater.

Service groups may be offered a discount provided maintenance projects are planned and approved in advance by our Facilities Manager.

20% discount given when multiple groups share the property.
