



Overnight Camping Permission Form For Teens Only, grades 7-12.



Overnight Camping on Thursday and Friday night is a special privilege for the teen classes. Youth, grades 7-12 have the option to stay over Thursday night, Friday night, or both.

Activities for overnight camping include: campfire cooking, extra swim time, recreation and evening worship service. This is a wonderful bonding time for youth!

WHAT TO BRING: Bring everything you would normally bring to Day Camp **plus:** sleeping bag or bedding, pillow, pajamas, toiletries, flashlight, extra pair of shoes. It is NOT recommended that teens bring expensive electronics with them– laptops, iPads, etc. Day Camp will not be responsible in the event these items are lost or damaged. Knives, matches, lighters and fireworks are also prohibited.

** Teens can also bring their own tents for overnight camping!

ELIGIBILITY: Youth must attend Day Camp at least 3 days in order to be eligible for the Thursday overnight. New campers whose first day at Camp is Wednesday or Thursday will not be permitted to stay over Thursday. Friday’s overnight requires a minimum of 3 days of camp attendance as well.

TRANSPORTATION: Thursday night’s camping will lead into regular Day Camp activities Friday morning. Campers only staying over on Thursday can return on the shuttle and be picked up Friday at the usual time. For Friday’s overnight, campers must be **picked up at Camp Paddy Run by 10 a.m. Saturday morning.**

CODE OF CONDUCT: Campers are expected to conduct themselves in a Christian manner– respecting God, the adult supervisors, one another, and camp property. Behavior not honoring this expectation will NOT be tolerated; this includes foul language, inappropriate displays of affection, media with explicit content and illegal substances. **In the event of a disciplinary issue, you will be asked to pick up your child immediately. Campers not showing proper conduct during Day Camp will not be permitted to stay overnight.**

Fees: \$10 for 1 night, \$20 for 2 nights; add this amount to the registration fee and return both to the address on the form **BY JUNE 5– NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Space is limited. Priority will be given to older/returning campers first, then in the order of which the forms were received.
