Special Notice regarding COVID-19 policies
For immediate release

The Camp Paddy Run Board of Directors met via teleconference on May 9, 2020 to discuss the summer camping season. The board voted unanimously to re-open Camp Paddy Run for all activities including private group rentals, Day Camp at Camp Paddy Run, hosted June 22-26, 2020 and Adventure Camp, hosted July 19-23.

This decision came after much discussion and deliberation with members of the Day Camp Ministry Team and after conversations with Kyle Butler, the camp's insurance agent. Some of the factors that contributed to this decision by the board were:

- Camp Paddy Run has 175 acres of land– which makes social distancing very easy.
- Day Camp is a fairly small program with low overhead costs and high adult-to-camper ratios that can swiftly adapt to changes and implementations for safe practices and to conform to government regulations.
- Parents, campers and individuals renting the property can stay updated on the latest information and policies by visiting our website, www.CampPaddyRun.org

The board stressed the importance of complying with all policies set forth by governmental entities when it comes to group size and allowed activities. Furthermore, adherence to the CDC guidelines is critical for the health & safety of our campers, including increased cleaning and disinfecting, social distancing, and providing personal protection gear as available.

We anticipate even more changes as the weeks progress and realize camp might not look the same this year as it has in summers past. While these are extremely challenging times, the Board of Directors are committed to the camp's mission and accept these challenges with great sobriety and diligence.
