Day Camp is for youth entering grades 1- 12 in the fall of 2026.

COST: \$75 per person.

Fee includes transportation to & from camp, snack, lunch & drinks, all study materials, craft supplies, lifeguard, T-shirt and liability insurance. The fee cannot be refunded if camper does not attend the entire week.
